Welcome Pastor Tony Gamley and his wife, Beryl

Our church has been reminded again of how God is at work all the time and desires for us to come along side and enter into a deeper relationship with him. While we all have been affected by the sudden departure of our pastor, God was not surprised and had a plan. We found an incredibly gifted man of God to serve as our interim pastor. He is experienced and will be able to connect well to all.

Reverend Anthony "Tony" Gamley was born, raised and educated in South Africa where he currently lives with his wife Beryl. They are the parents of three married adult sons, living in New Zealand, England and Oregon. Pastor Tony has a strong educational background. He holds a Bachelor of Divinity from Rhodes University, a University Teacher's License in Pianoforte and a

BA in Musicology from the University of South Africa. He also holds a Doctor of Ministry from San Francisco Theological Seminary. Tony has completed three different Interim Training programs and a further "Beyond Conflict" training.

Pastor Tony was ordained as a Minister of Word and Sacraments with the Presbyterian Church of South Africa in 1966 and has been a minister in good standing of the PCUSA since 1973. He became a naturalized US citizen in Hawaii in 2011 while serving there as an interim for three years. Pastor Tony has served as a solo Pastor, Co-Pastor, Head of Staff, College Lecturer, Superintendent of Education of Religious Education programs and Interim Pastor for four separate congregations (Washington State, Oakland CA, Hawaii, and New Zealand).

Pastor Tony's chief passion in ministry is pastoral care. In his own words, he tries to instill "mutual care, understanding and forgiveness, respect and kindness. As Christ loved the church, so the members of the Body are urged to love one another." He maintains an open-door policy with opportunities for confidential one-on-one conversations. Encouraging and participating in home visits to the church family is important to him and he relates well to young people, the aged and the ill. Over his years of ministry, he has developed a deep appreciation of the role of the laity.

The IPNC (Interim Pastor Nominating Committee) have found Pastor Tony to be a caring, understanding, approachable person and a good listener. Tony is a skilled bridge builder and communicator having served in multiple interim settings with high praise from colleagues who knew him. His sermons are thoughtful and scripturally-based. Tony's wide international experience, including his enduring commitment to the anti-apartheid movement in South Africa, has given him the opportunity to have a broad, insightful view of the strengths and needs of both the world and individual communities; these are reflected in his ministry and mission. In his Statement of Faith, Tony says, "Over the years, passages like Amos 5:24, Micah 6:8, and Luke

4:18,19 have informed my outlook on the equitable treatment of God's children - especially the poor, oppressed and voiceless."

The IPNC and Session are happy to welcome Pastor Tony to First Presbyterian of Ukiah as our Interim Pastor. We are working to determine a start date and will communicate to the congregation when it is set. Please join us in praying for safe and smooth travels for Pastor Tony and a good transition to FPCU.

Dear Church Family,

My family and I are so blessed to be a part of First Presbyterian Church of Ukiah. I appreciate the love and care you show towards one another, your openness to the leading of the Holy Spirit and your desire to grow in your faith. The last five months have been full. We have experienced good things, challenges and changes. As we navigate these waters, we are reminded that God is always with us and He is mightier than anything we face. God also provides for us in extraordinary ways.

One of the ways God is providing for us is by sending Pastor Anthony "Tony" Gamley as our interim pastor. Session is looking forward to welcoming Pastor Tony to our church in the near future.

There may be some questions on why we need an interim pastor. According to the Book of Order all monthly session meetings and special session meetings must be moderated by a PCUSA pastor, ordained in Word and Sacrament (G-3.0201). In addition, all congregational meetings where church membership votes take place must be moderated by a PCUSA pastor of Word and Sacrament (G-1.0504). The Presbytery of the Redwoods has been graciously supporting us for the last several months by suppling a moderator for our session and our congregational meetings. They have been very accommodating for which we are grateful. Hiring an interim pastor allows us to have our own moderator for these meetings. Pastor Tony will also serve as Head of Staff, which we have been operating without since March.

So how do I fit in? I am ordained in Word and Sacrament in the Evangelical Covenant Church. Although I am ordained, it is not in the Presbyterian Church USA and therefore I cannot serve as the moderator for session or congregational meetings. I was hired by FPCU as the Director of Youth and Families and therefore cannot serve as the Head of Staff as that would blur the lines of job

descriptions. We desire to maintain the integrity of the church's structure so that we can function well in the future when we call our next lead pastor.

I am looking forward to serving with Pastor Tony and benefitting from his experience, education, gifting and call to serve internationally. God is good and know what we need in each season. Please join me in praying for travel clearance and safety for both Tony and his wife, Beryl. May we thank God for blessing us once again.
